**Background**

Alternatives to Incarceration (ATI) Work Group focused its initial planning on persons with clinical behavioral health needs, generating an *Interim Report* in June, 2019. However, the ATI Work Group agreed to engage more groups and communities during the second phase of planning, starting in July, 2019. Below is an updated calendar with more specific information on the community planning and engagement activities that will be conducted in September.

**Justice-Involved Populations**

An Ad Hoc Committee was established to address the needs of people who identify as (1) cisgender women; (2) transgender, gender-non-conforming; and/or (3) lesbian, gay, bisexual and/or queer. We developed this Committee to promote equity in addressing gender identity and sexual orientation in addition to our ongoing commitment to racial equity. This Committee will review existing recommendations to determine if any need to be tailored for these particular subgroups or if anything important is missing from our roadmap.
